- Skills and experience in the nominated occupation.
- You hold the relevant Australian registration or licencing.

Spouse / partner

If you wish to claim Matrix points

- have proof of the relationship
- competent English; or hold an Australian passport

Proficient

You, and any migrating dependents

- Are living overseas.
- Have not lived in Australia for the last 12 months.
- Do not hold a current Australian visa (or bridging visa), except an Australian visitor visa.

RESIDENT APPLICANT

Eligibility

You must meet one of the following:

- Occupation on the latest ACT Critical Skills List.
- Primary holder of a subclass 457/482 visa sponsored by an ACT employer
- The majority owner of an eligible registered business located in the ACT

Employment

You worked in Canberra for the last three (3) months:

- 1. Employee.
- 2. Self-employed and you are not claiming Matrix points as a Small Business Owner.
- 3. Small Business Owner.

English

Proficient

- Unless your nominated occupation:
- 1. is Chef 351311.
- 2. has an ANZSCO skill level 3 to 5.

Resident in Canberra

For the last three (3) months and continue until the date of invitation

Spouse / partner

- 1. Resident in Canberra for the last three (3) months or living overseas
- 2. Have proof of the relationship
- Competent English; or hold an Australian passport
